POSTER SESSION INSTRUCTIONS

The EPC 2014 Poster Sessions will be held in the southern part of the Main Foyer, which is on the ground floor of the main building of Corvinus University, the conference venue. Times and schedules can be found in the (preliminary) program on the conference website. The poster board is 100 cm wide and 200 cm high. Each poster board will be identified by a poster number. Refer to the final program to confirm the number assigned to your poster presentation. The presenting author should be present during the poster presentation.

Poster preparation

Title - Prepare a banner for the top of the poster indicating the title, author(s) and affiliation(s).

Illustrations - Figures should be designed to be viewed from a distance, and should use clear, visible graphics. Each figure or table should have a heading in large typeface. Detailed information should be provided in a legend below in smaller typeface. Since there is no text accompanying a poster, the figure legend should describe concisely the content of the figure and the conclusions. Details of the methodology should be kept brief and should be placed at the end of the legend.

Layout - Avoid long textual passages and use graphs and diagrams as much as possible. Push pins will be provided.

You may have copies of abstracts available for distribution during the poster session.
